Your inaugural lecture in print and digital

Your lecture will be made into both a printed publication and a PDF file.

We strive to make the printed product available on the day of your inaugural lecture. To make this happen, we ask you to provide your text within the timeframe of this brochure's planning.

The printed version of your lecture will be added to the UG collection. The digital version will be published by University of Groningen Press as a PDF file in the *Inaugural lectures* series.

All inaugural lectures are published under a Creative Commons license: CC-BY-NC-ND 4.0. As the author you will remain to be the copyright holder.

We understand that you want to keep working on your lecture until the last moment. Therefore, your text for publication doesn't need to be identical to your inaugural lecture, although it naturally needs to be broadly the same. If you would like your publication to contain photographs, diagrams, images etc., make sure that you have arranged for the reuse of these.

After you have provided the text and illustrations, we will further process those. UG will take care of the production costs.

It is possible to order printed copies, but these will be at your own expense. Please contact us for a price quote relevant to additional printed copies (typically approx. € 5.00 per book).

We at University of Groningen Press would like to receive your text, images, and other materials five weeks before your inaugural speech at the latest. Contact address: ugp@rug.nl.

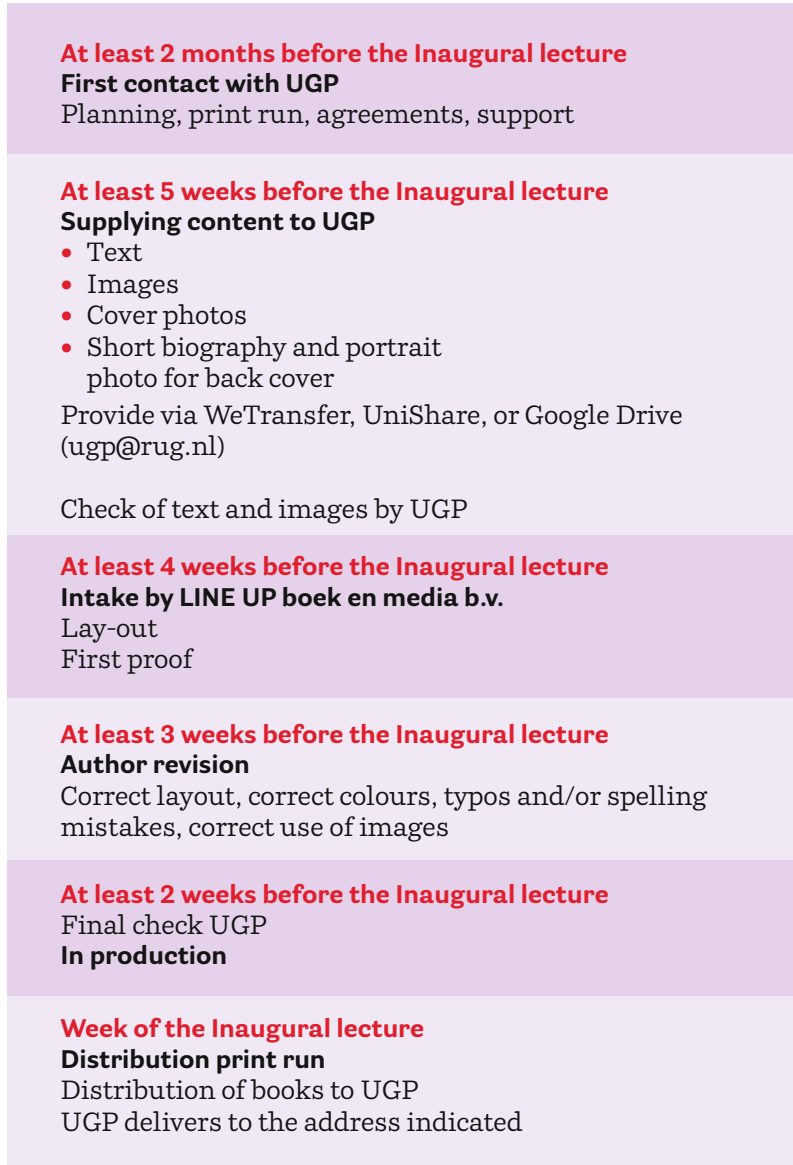


Figure 1 Workflow publishing Inaugural lectures

General points of attention

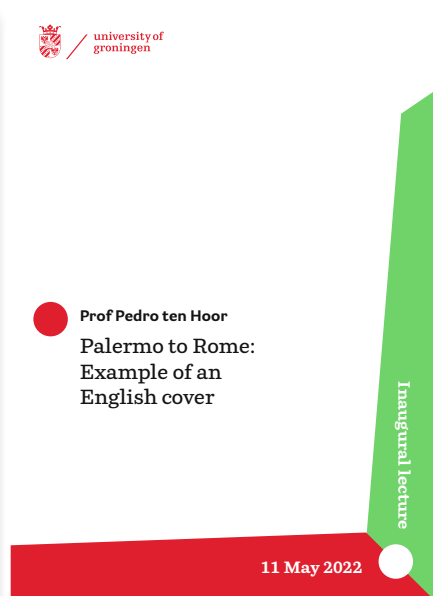
To make sure the production process (typesetting, lay-out) runs as smoothly as possible, we give you several points of attention:

- Please provide an indication of the word count at first contact, so we can give you an estimate of the volume (and costs).
- Supply your text preferably as a .doc file (Word).
- Keep your lay-out as tidy as possible. Don't use more than three Header levels. Avoid the use of Styles as much as possible. *Italics* and **bold** types are both allowed, but preferably **not combined**.
- Start each chapter with Header level 1.
- Start a new paragraph with a hard return (Enter).
- Do not use manual hyphenation. Your text will be reformat-
ted, which could cause hyphenations to appear in different
locations within the text.
- You can include images with a caption in the text. NB Make
sure to use the correct source references with any image.
- While formatting the text, images can end up in a different
location. Be aware of this issue when creating your refer-
ence. So please don't use a reference such as "see figure 1
below", but rather use "see figure 1".
- Please provide original images separately. Preferably as .tiff
or .jpg files, resolution 300 dpi or higher, minimum size of
10 x 15 cm or 1180 x 1700 pixels.

- During the production of the book, images, charts and schedules could be redrawn in a uniform style at the production company.
- Provide the files through WeTransfer, UniShare, or Google Drive.
- A digital print proof will be made, in which you can indicate final amendments. NB Substantive changes are no longer a possibility at this stage.
- Logically, you can elaborate on the subject in the book and thank more people than might be possible during your inaugural lecture.
- We can offer support in processing references and (foot) notes within the text.
- We recommend the use of software such as RefWorks to easily create a reference list.

Execution

- Size: 14.5 x 21 cm (A5). This brochure is made in the size and style of the printed inaugural lectures.
- Volume: on average 24 to 32 pages, approx. 5,000 – 10,000 words.
- Colour: Full-colour cover / options for the use of colour images in the interior are available.
- Cover: photo/image on the front cover and a (portrait) photo on the back cover.



Production

The company LINE UP boek en media bv provides a uniform lay-out and production based on a template in which the UG corporate identity is used.

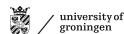

On the cover, we would like to make use of a photo. You are free to use any design for this cover photo. Per request, we can provide a typographical cover. For the back cover, we would like to receive a portrait photo and a short bio (approx. 125 words). Costs for taking a photo or the redemption of rights won't be reimbursed by UG.

For the cover template we use three spot colours: pink for all UMCG/medical inaugural lectures, green for FSE lectures, and blue for SSH lectures.
